## **SACNW Meeting Minutes**

December 11<sup>th</sup>, 2024

**President's Welcome:** Al Domescik opened the meeting at 7:05 p.m. thanking everyone for attending. Al thanked Kristen, the owner of SomePlace South, and staff for hosting the meeting. He then gave a brief overview of the organization for the guests that were at SomePlace South and advised that questions are welcome at any time.

**Treasurer's Report:** Presented by Al

Al told the membership that in November we collected approximately \$9,800 and spent approximately \$12,000. One of the big expenses this month was a \$2,500 cart repair.

The December 1<sup>st</sup> Poker Run hosted by Someplace South raised \$1,558. Al thanked everyone who attended as well as Someplace South, Playa De Sala, Stax, Lighthouse and Happy's for their participation.

Al gave a reminder that our main fundraising event of the year, the Kelly McGuire Beach Party is coming up on February 15<sup>th</sup> and we have raffle tickets for the big raffle.

Please remember that SACNW operates solely on member contributions! All contributions are used for Patrol Salaries and expenses needed to operate i.e., Golf Cart repairs, Fuel, Bank Fees etc. All administrative costs are volunteer and donations!

**Note:** Social Security is paid based on the prior month's salaries.

**Security Report:** Presented by Patrol Officer Dominguez.

- November 07: At 7:48 a.m., Patrol was informed of a suspicious golfcart with two Hispanic male persons entering a construction site, checks were made and the two were identified as being construction from mile 4.4

- November 07: At 9:51 p.m., Patrol and police were informed that someone was trying to enter a unit at a resort at mile 2.5. Checks were made in the area, and no one was found.

-November 20: At 3:05 a.m., Patrol was stopped by a female asking for assistance claiming she was brought to the area against her will. Police took over the matter.

November 30: At 12:30 a.m., Patrol and Polie were stopped by a guest at mile 2.5 requesting assistance to locate her husband that went missing that night at 7p.m. after leaving a tattoo shop. The patrol assisted the guest to the main police station to file a missing person's report.

December 04: 10:18 p.m., Patrol was informed that a guest from mile 4.5 was refusing to pay their dinner bill. Police took over the matter.

December 08: 11:37 p.m., Patrol received a report of 2 suspicious persons on a property at mile 3.5. Checks were made and the people were identified to be workers at the property.

- During this period, 38 people were searched.

-Al reminded everyone the party date is Saturday night February 15, 2025, 4 pm to 9 pm
