Security Report:

SACNW Patrol Mr. Coye presented the Security Report for September:

31+ people were stopped, searched, and escorted out of the area.

One major incident involved a home break-in, and the perpetrator was detained within 24 hours.

A message from the Patrol stressed the importance of securing homes when designing exterior open showers. Community cooperation in keeping the Patrol informed is crucial for the officers' success.

New Business:

Road Signs: Joe Lawrence will reinstall mile marker signs that were knocked down.

Green Dump: The gate was broken but has been commissioned for repair. Non-green dumping has resumed but is expected to decrease with the fence fixed.

Road: The road grader will be used to pave the streets as soon as it becomes available, and it will be used to grade the roads to the south.

Carts: Both carts have been fixed and are operational. They are registered with the Police, with gas expenses covered by the Police, and they are specifically for SACW Patrol use.

Trash Cans: All expressed gratitude to Kevin and Randy Watts for completing the Trash Can Stands and placing them throughout the community.

San Pedro Christmas Collection: Someplace South will host a lip-sync competition on November 19th to support this year's Christmas collection.

Poker Run: The Poker Run will start on Saturday, November 5th, at noon at Someplace South.

Kelly Maguire: The date for this year's Kelly Maguire Concert is set for Sunday, January 28th, at Lighthouse. The event will feature a \$5,000 raffle and a silent auction, with the help of Kristen of Someplace South, who successfully managed the Saga event earlier this year.
