**Security Report:** -- Officer Coy presented the security report for April - May:

Wednesday, April 11th, 1:15pm - Patrol and Police responded to a call that a boat had docked at a pier down south with what appeared to be groceries. The police certified that the men's papers were in order.

Sunday, April 24<sup>th</sup>, 9:15pm – Police and Patrol checked out a purple golf cart that had crashed into a power pole and then tried to leave the scene. The driver was forced to stop and then started insulting the police officer; he was detained.

Tuesday, April 26<sup>th</sup>, 7:45am – Police and patrol noticed an abandoned golf cart. Police were informed that the cart had been stolen during the night.

2:55pm - Police and Patrol responded to a call that a person was having chest pains. Triple R was informed and took over.

Monday, May 2<sup>nd</sup> 7:14pm – Patrol was informed of a suspicious person that had abandoned a blue golf cart; the person was not found; only the stolen cart..

Friday, May 6, 5:30am – Patrol was informed that a suspicious person entered the area on foot and then exited on a bike; he was followed and the bicycle was recovered but the person ran off into the DFC area.

Sunday, May 8<sup>th</sup>, 1:45am – Patrol was informed of an accident that had happened; police and patrol responded and noticed a very damaged 6 seater golf cart and a tourist bleeding from the right hand and foot. Triple R was notified and responded; the lady had a broken foot.

Sunday, May 8<sup>th</sup>, 9:30am – Patrol was informed of a burglary at a house down south where there was a window broken. No one was found and the police were notified.

During the month, 5 suspicious boats were investigated, 27 suspicious people and 3 suspicious couples were escorted out of the neighbourhood, and 4 golf carts with problems were assisted.
