## **SACNW Meeting Minutes**

September 11, 2024

**President's Welcome:** Al Domescik opened the meeting at 7:00 p.m. thanking everyone for attending. Al thanked Kristen, the owner of SomePlace South, and staff for hosting the meeting. He then gave a brief overview of the organization for the guests that were at SomePlace South and advised that questions are welcome at any time.

**Treasurer's Report:** Presented by Al.

Al told the membership that in August we collected approximately \$10,000 and spent \$10,254 on Payroll and \$1,745 on golf cart repairs, about \$1200 more than July – both carts needed more than routine maintenance.

The Poker Run on September 1 raised \$1,437 BZ. Mary and Pete's dog Jack won again with four 10's. As always, he generously donated back the winnings but kept the restaurant gift certificates. Diane Sheehan won the 50/50 and did the same.

Please remember that SACNW operates solely on member contributions! All contributions are used for Patrol Salaries and expenses needed to operate i.e., Golf Cart repairs, Fuel, Bank Fees etc. All administrative costs are volunteer and donations!

**Note:** Social Security is paid based on the prior month's salaries.

**Security Report:** Presented by patrolman Mr. Dominguez.

-Friday August 11<sup>th</sup> Around 3am a male person was stopped and searched in the area. He gave the Police Officer a false name, so he was taken to the police station to be questioned and charged.

-August 22<sup>nd</sup> at 12:18 pm a male person was stopped and questioned and subsequently detained for a court violation. Patrol handed it over to the police.

-August 24<sup>th</sup> at 6 pm patrol received a call that shots were fired at a location in the neighborhood. Upon further investigation it seems the shots were fired from a passing boat.

- During this period, 30 people were searched and several escorted from the area.
