Security Report: SACNW Patrol Mr Medina presented the Security Report:

During the month of September to October:

33 people were stopped, searched and escorted out of area

Saturday, September 17th 2022 At 5.45am Manager of Royal Caribbean reported that a gas tank had been stolen from their rental apartment. They were advised to make a formal report to the station.

Monday, September 19th **2022,** At 3.30am Police and patrol reports a cream colored purse containing cash and other documents. Items were handed over to the owner and signed.

Tuesday September 20th, 2022 At 10.10pm Police and Patrol responded to an owner requesting assistance with a large snake. The snake was caught and released unharmed. Incident occurred at Tarpon Bay.

Saturday, September 24th, 2022 At 6.05am Patrol and Police responded to a domestic report whereby a female claimed that her husband had hit her. She was informed to make a report and the husband was detained and handed over to the Police.

Monday, October 3rd 2022. At 2.45am Caribe Island security called requesting assistance with a domestic dispute, a women claimed she had been hit by her boyfriend. Female refused to make a report and was assisted home.

Saturday October 9th, 2022 At 10.00am Owner of Twin Dolphin reported a blue golf cart attempted to steal his golf cart from his home.

Security comments

The Patrol officer reminded residents that security starts at home and to be sure to lock your carts, bodegas, doors and windows. He reminded that during times of high seas there are beach combers looking for valuable items that wash up and if a door is left open or an item left unlocked, opportunists will take the opportunity to steal. Patrol and Police are always available in the event of domestic violence situations but for the matter to be resolved the victim must report to the police or there is no grounds to keep the abuser in custody or the victim safe.

New Business:

Kevin Owen and Randy Watts "SACNW"met with Robert Torriz of Town Council "TC" and together toured the neighborhood to discuss the following areas

Road - Culverts for Road

SACNW & TC- viewed the areas needing Culverts,

SACNW -suggested to TC that if the owners bought the Pipe the TC will do the work. It was identified that there were many driveways that do not have pipes. The TC confirmed that they will do the work if the resident buy the pipe. Pricing and details are being sourced and will be provided to homeowners.

For the road TC are sourcing Material from Orange Walk that is better then the material that is currently be sourced from Northern Ambergris Caye.

Signs - Sign removal

TC identified and made a list of signs that are within 3 ft of the road ways It was established that Signs are not to be placed on telegraph Posts and are to be 3 ft from the road and if on private property have permission to be there. Any sign within 3 feet of the road is to be removed by TC. TC will first send a message/letter/email to each of the sign owners giving notice prior to removal.
